## OBITUARY

Edward P. Burns, 86, formerly of RD Boyertown, died Sunday morning at Coatesville Veterans Administration Medical Center.

Born in Mahanoy Plane, he was a son of the late Joseph P. and Mary A. Harkins Burns.



A Navy veteran of World War II, he received a Purple Heart.

Mr. Burns was employed by the former Orr & Sembower Inc. as a boilermaker for many years before retiring.

He was a life member of Pulaski American Legion Post 929, and Lt. Gen. Hunter Ligett Post 38, Veterans of Foreign Wars, both of Reading; VFW National Home; and Berks County Chapter 231, Order of the Purple Heart.

He was named an honorary citizen of Boys Town in 1955.

Surviving are a brother, Michael J., Lemoyne; three sisters, Anna M. Yost, Boyertown, Margaret M. Conley, Saint Clair, and Josephine E. Kondraski, Reading.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday from St. Margaret's Roman Catholic Church, Reading. Interment will be in St. Joseph's Cemetery, Frackville. John P. Feeney Funeral Home, Reading, is in charge of arrangements.
