WAPPINGERS FALLS — Felix DiGregorio, 75, a communicant of St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church and a lifelong Village of Wappingers Falls resident, died Thursday at Vassar Brothers Hospital in Poughkeepsie.

Mr. DiGregorio worked for the New York State Department of Transportation for 40 years. He retired as a foreman.
